4. Term of Study

Doctoral Program: four years

5. Requirement for completion

The student is required to register for at four years in this course, receive the guidance for research of medical science, and to master thirty units of the compulsory subjects.

6. Presentation of Diplomas

Niigata University confers the degree of Doctor of Philosophy on the student satisfying the above conditions (see Section 5) and passing both his/her thesis and graduation examination.

7. Fees

(1) Entrance Fee: ¥282,000 (estimated)

(2) Tuition Fee: ¥535,800 per year (estimated)

8. Exemption and Reduction of Entrance Fee

The student can be exempted from the total or one-half of entrance fee upon our selection if one applies at the entrance procedures. One of the following conditions must be satisfied:

- (1) The student who has serious financial difficulties and excellent academic records.
- (2) The student who has serious difficulties to pay the entrance fee because the person who bears school expenses, i.e., the guarantor dies, or because the student oneself or the guarantor suffers a disaster within a year prior to the entrance.
- (3) Applicants deemed by the University as having circumstances or reasons comparable to those mentioned above.

9. Exemption and Reduction of Tuition Fee

The student can be exempted from the total or one-half of tuition fee upon our selection if one applies after the entrance. One of the following conditions must be satisfied

(1) The student who has serious financial difficulties and excellent academic records.

- (2) The student who has serious financial difficulties to pay the tuition fee because the person who bears school expenses, i.e., the guarantor dies, or because the student oneself or the guarantor suffers a disaster within half year prior to the date of payment of tuition fee (in case of new students; within a year prior to the entrance.)
- (3) Applicants deemed by the University as having circumstances or reasons comparable to those mentioned above.
