Drug allergies from bedside to bench

Adverse drug reactions are the 6th leading cause of death in westernized countries. Allergic reactions constitute an important part of it. Especially, IgE-mediated reactions that are frequently unexpected, life-threatening, and sometimes fatal. However, it is not always easy to find a culprit drug responsible for anaphylaxis. Sometimes the real culprits are hidden. Despite these challenges, it is important to remember that the IgE-mediated immunity fades with time and that drug allergies to medications can be outgrown in most cases.
